

The team who served the meal included Chris, Janette, Eric from Zion, Deacon Cathy, Charley, and Avery. Maddie helped with cooking and cleaning, while Anne assisted with the cake and ice cream. Father Steve greeted our guests and helped create a warm and welcoming atmosphere. Overall, it was a fantastic night!

Tuesday, April 16th:

The hosts for the event were Tom and Shelley. The menu included hamburgers, condiments, carrots, chips, fruit, and cookies. The expected number of people was 160, and the actual count was 160, including 25 deliveries to Bicentennial Manor, with eight guests dining in. There were 152 pickups. The volunteers who helped and made the event successful were Cathy, Steve, Maya, Chris (every week), Chris (church), Maddie, Jodie, and Vicky—thanks to all the volunteers who lent their time and effort.

Tuesday, April 23rd:

The members of the vestry hosted the meal. They served taco salad, fruit, and cookies. There were 133 meals served, of which 19 were delivered to the Bicentennial, seven were dine-in, and 107 were takeout.


